West Creston Fire Protection News:

West Creston now has a fire insurance rating of 3B; letters have been sent out to the valley insurance companies with the appropriate information.

West Creston Fire Station #61 is linked to 911 emergency callout and has local responders on call with pagers. Practice and preplanning helps to ensure you get the best possible response in an emergency.

This spring, firefighters with the Creston Fire & Rescue will be doing evaluations of property accesses. This preplanning process is to help determine whether the fire engine can safely make it up a driveway or if the bush truck will be used to pull fire hose lines up the driveway. Do your part to assist emergency vehicles, fire or ambulance in locating your property.

Make sure your house numbers are clearly visible - day or night – from the road.

House Numbers for West Creston Residents:
